Hymn: Sprit of the god

Introduction:

The beatitudes are prophetic declarations made on the conviction of establishing the Kingdom of God. The beatitude does not give us do's and don'ts but they help us to develop a genuine attitude towards human life and others. Beatitudes reveal that the poor, the destitute and the deprived are close to God's heart.

Adoration: (All Together)

Lord Jesus, the blessings you have bestowed upon us are beyond measure. We come before you today to offer our beautiful thanksgiving and homage. Our beloved and changeless friend Jesus, accept our hearts full of gratitude and love towards you. We are grateful to you for these precious moments of praise, peace and divine intimacy with you. We praise you for your bounteous providence and loving protection. Thank you Lord Jesus for saving us from many dangers of body and soul. For this, we thank and praise you Lord.

Penitential Rite: (Response: Pardon us o lord)

1. Forgive us O Lord, for not having become visible signs of your gentleness and peace to our brothers and sisters. (R)
2. Forgive us O Lord, for being unfaithful to you in the face of trials and opposition. (R)
3. Forgive us O Lord, our unwillingness to share the sufferings of others by our love and concern. (R)
4. Sorry Lord for closing our eyes and hearts to those who needed our friendship and understanding. (R)
5. Pardon us O Lord for seeking name and fame for ourselves at the cost of others. (R)

Scripture Reading (St. Mat 5: 1-12)



Reflection:

To be like Jesus, we are called to put on the attitudes of Jesus in our life. Beatitudes and nothing else but the attitudes of Jesus. Heaven is awarded to those who kept their faith and fought the fight passing through the tribulations of the world. Let us be concerned with the things that are above and not be lost in the glamour of the passing things of the world. Jesus himself is our eternal beatitude. He gave himself as our recompense and reward. Let us dream of heaven and the glory to come.

Intercessory Prayers: (Response: Lord, listen to our prayers)

1. Lord it is for heaven that you have created us. Heaven is to see you face to face. Remove from us everything that hinders us from our entry into heaven. (R)
2. Lord it is your grace that enables us to obtain beatitudes. Help us to persevere in grace and avoid every sin and shortcomings that destroy divine life. (R)
3. Jesus Lord, we are weak and frail, pour your spirit in us and strengthen us to resist the temptations of the evil one and to conquer our self. (R)
4. Let not the cares of the world immerse us in material things. Help us to raise our heart to things that are above, may we long for the lasting joys of the eternal home. (R)

Thanksgiving Prayer: (All Together)

O Jesus we thank you for your boundless love. Thank you for having given yourself entirely to us. We thank you for your presence in the Eucharist, thank you for your faithfulness. We adore you, we love you, we praise you. We give you thanks and we praise you.

Adoration Hymn: Let us bow in adoration

To the Sacrament so great so great
Here is new and perfect worship
All the old must terminate
Senses cannot grasp this marvel
Faith must serve to compensate
Glory, honour adoration
Let us sing with one accord
Praised be God, almighty Father
