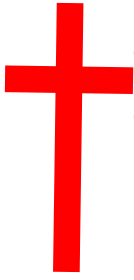
Let love sink in and permeates your being as you think of God and may be of a person you love.

Introduction:

Imagine yourself climbing up the mount of Calvary and at the foot of the cross soaked with the blood of Jesus dripping from the crown of thorns with Mary his mother and John his beloved disciple on either side. Then descend and take another along with you to share this experience. Then both of you come and take one more. This is the healing and forgiveness that should take place in every family, home, community and in the globe. Let us ask Mary to clothe us with her mantle and protect us as we pray the Rosary daily in our homes.

Mary brought the WORD into the world. Let us draw a line sketch of our lords with the following characteristics as we study the gospel.

Our Lord Bending: the woman committed adultery. Jesus said, " He who is without sin let him cast the first stone and as no one did so Jesus said neither will I , other instances of God's mercy, tack and compassion the Canaanite women healing the sick, blind and washing the feet of his disciples.



Our Lord, looking up to his heavenly father, “ If it be possible let this chalice pass from me nevertheless not my will but thine be done.” At the last supper he looked up to heaven blessed, broke and gave to his disciples.

Our lord giving with outstretched hands and palms facing upwards giving himself to us giving us all we ask for... ask and you shall receive.

If you at any time doubt whether the lord knows what you are suffering, whether he knows what paralysis means, think of Him paralyzed, outstretched on the cross, if you pick your finger and feel pain think of Him scoffed, mocked, ridiculed and derided and you will find that there is nothing you suffer which He has not experienced. The more you know a person, the closer you try to come to him, know God through his word... The gospel and come closer to Him in your daily life.

Adoration: (All Together)

O Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we bow down before you, we adore you. God our Father, we acknowledge your supremacy and together with angelic court we adore you. We thank you for your presence and we adore you with our whole heart. We offer you our love and affection. O spirit of love, our advocate and inspirer come into our souls and live with us. We offer you our humble adoration and veneration.

Open our eyes Lord, we ant to see Jesus.

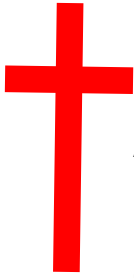
Penitential Rite: (Response: Jesus Christ, have mercy on us)

1. Sorry for the times we were not aware of your real presence within and around us. (R)
2. We ask your pardon lord for the many times we have given up our daily prayers. (R)
3. Have mercy on us O lord for we have hurt and criticized others. (R)
4. Sorry Lord for we have gone away from you when we were in trouble. (R)
5. Forgive us Jesus for not living in your presence. (R)

Scripture Reading (Rom 1: 8-15)

Intercessory Prayers: (Response: Lord, listen to our prayers)

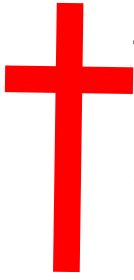
1. Holy Mary, Mother of God pray that we may accept our lives as God's plan for us. (R)
